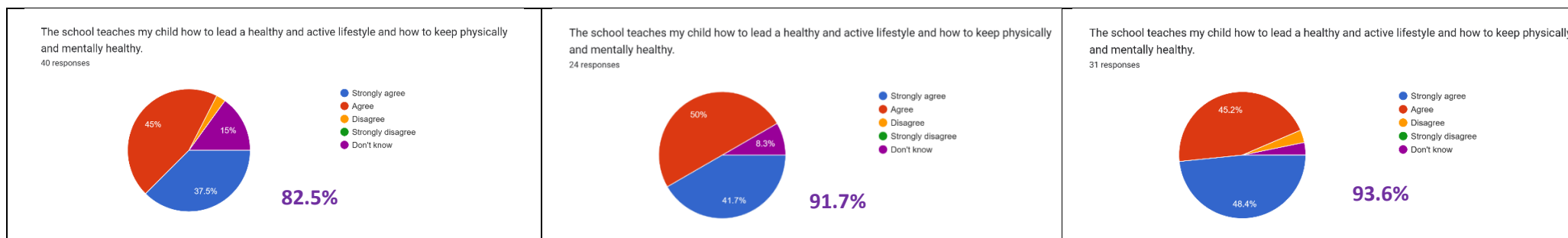










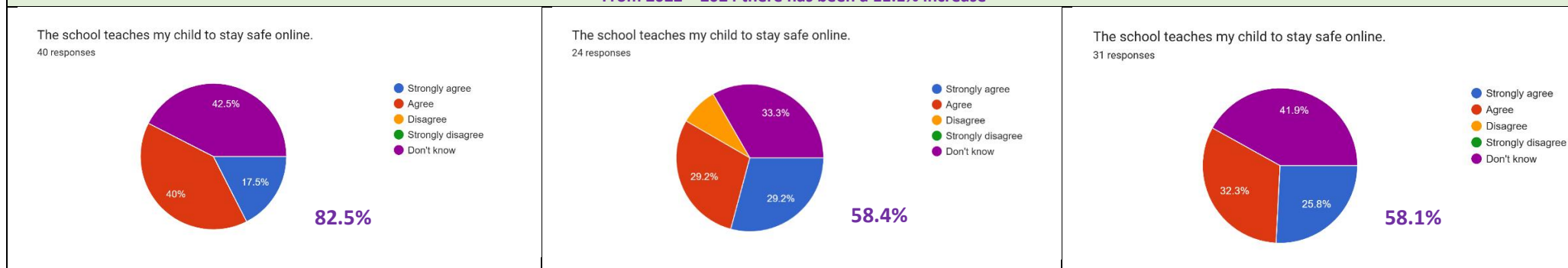


93.6% of parents/carers feel that the school teachers their child how to lead a healthy and active lifestyle and how to keep physically and mentally healthy.
